

DIY RV ROOF INSPECTION

What should you look for

MAKE SURE YOU ARE ABLE TO GET ON YOUR RV ROOF

General rule of thumb is if you don't have a ladder on your RV you should not be on the roof.



START WITH THE SEAMS

An easy place to start is with the seams of the roof. Check for breaks or cracks along the side edges of the RV roof.



CHECK AROUND VENTS, SKYLIGHTS AND AC UNITS

Check all the caulk around anything on top of your roof for any cracks or breaks where water could leak in.



CHECK THE MAIN PART OF THE ROOF MEMBRANCE

Carefully walk along your roof if you are able to and inspect for any rips, pinholes, or any other area water could enter.



TAPE AND RESEAL AS NEEDED

For any areas that need to be resealed be sure to remove any old caulking first and use roof tape and self leveling caulk.
